Photoshop

- help system important to look at

Bracketting

shutter speed →

1/60

↓ need tripod

OR surface to sit on

Average start 1/125

1/125 @ 5.6

1/253 @ 8 or 11

* look up exposure modes (center, multi zone, spot) * new

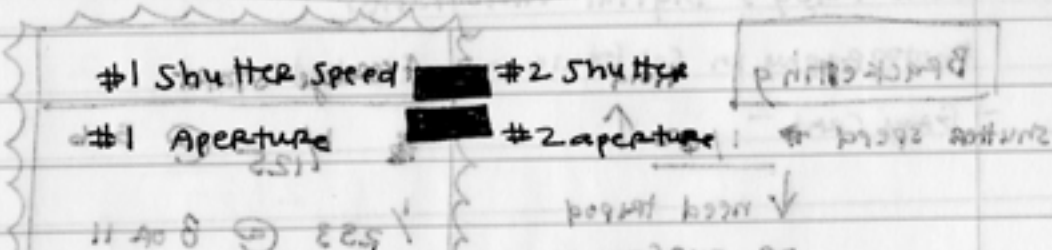
(aperture mode helps with depth of field)

change aperture to see different affects - with light.

More Bracketting Tips

- you can bracket with white balance too
- set ISO and don't change it - work with aperture or shutter, etc...
- in manual mode you should keep some notes because camera often registers it as simple manual and info is lost
- half step lock will not work in manual

* equivalency exposure



* exposure modes / Metering modes
multi zone, spot, center weighted

(try center & spot) - reading light meter

* focus mode

what (are you basing exposure on?)

depth of field

don't zoom, play with aperture in aperture mode
