3<sup>rd</sup> Place: Mural design award (can be 18"x 24" or larger) for larger scale work - may be commissioned by Student

Services depending on funding.

#### **Entry Rules & Requirements:**

- Entries must be original work.
- **Deadline for Entries must be submitted by Friday, April 29**<sup>th</sup>, **from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.,** and delivered to the Student Affairs Office, 1<sup>st</sup> floor Bertolini Student Center with an entry form (below).
- Limit of one submission.
- All submissions must be ready to hang.
- Deadline to pick up work: **Sunday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m**. or make reasonable arrangements with the Day Under the Oaks Coordinator.

#### Medium:

- Oil, acrylic, mixed media
- Canvas, wood panels
- Print

#### **Dimensions:**

Minimum 18"x 24" and anything larger.

#### **Theme: Our Diverse Community**

Artwork should reflect the theme "Our Diverse Community." The theme should refer to Santa Rosa Junior College's commitment to a learning community that uses sustainable practices and promotes a strong culture of inclusivity and diversity, as well bio diversity.
